General English – 15, 21 or 30 hours

University Pathway Course

- The course comprises 3 terms x 10 weeks.

Autumn Term: October 10th 2011 – December 16th 2011

Winter Term: January 9th 2012 – March 16th 2012

Spring Term: April 10th 2012 – June 15th 2012

- Study hours: 25 hours per week of General English, IELTS and academic English
- Entry requirements: IELTS 4.5 or equivalent

Skola's University Pathway course offers students two routes to University in the UK:

- Students who achieve IELTS 6.5 and have the requisite high school qualifications will be able to

apply to the university of their choice. The school provides a comprehensive university application service.

- Students who achieve IELTS 5.5 will study year 1 of the degree programme at one of our partner International Colleges. They will then join the affiliated University for years 2 and 3. The final degree is issued by the University. Our International College partners are LIBT Brunel (London), ICWS Swansea, PDIC Plymouth and CRIC (Cambridge).

Study and Work

SKOLA offers a fantastic range of Study and Work programmes in the UK:

Workskills Plus - Open to all students

- A worldwide recognised qualification, ideal for young people wishing to learn the skills that they need to succeed in the workplace - Interview Skills, applying for a job, presentations, project management, starting a business etc.
- Course duration is 26 weeks study x 15 hours per week + 26 weeks paid work placement in a hotel or 18 weeks study x 15 hours per week + 18 weeks paid work placement in a hotel.
- The course is open to all students with an English level of IELTS 5.5 or equivalent.

General English + paid work placement: Course open to European Union students only

- General English + paid work placement in a hotel. Study period 8 or 12 weeks + work placement of 12 – 26 weeks. Extra weeks of English available if required.
- General English + paid work placement in a London based restaurant. Minimum 4 weeks study + 8 week work placement. Extra weeks of English and work placement available if required.

Whichever option you choose, you have a great opportunity to spend time in the UK, perfect your English as well as cover some of your costs in a paid work placement.
