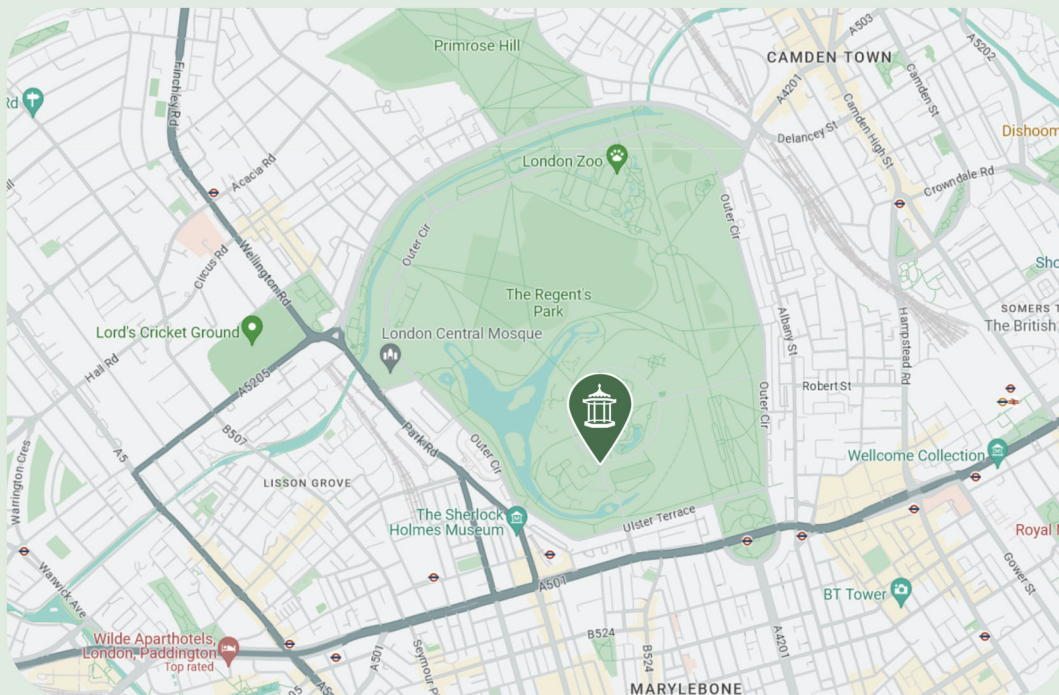




NUTFORD HOUSE
